



**REGULATIONS 1 – 8** Unchanged.

**REGULATION 9: SUBSTANTIVE LAW-RELATED WORK EXPERIENCE  
REQUIREMENT**

Each applicant for licensure as a limited license legal technician shall show proof of having completed 1,500 hours of substantive law-related work experience supervised by a licensed lawyer as required by APR 5(c). The experience requirement shall be completed no more than three years before and 40 months after the date of the LLLT practice area examination that the applicant passed and must be completed by July 31, 2023~~2~~. The proof shall be provided in such form as the Bar requires, but shall include at a minimum:
